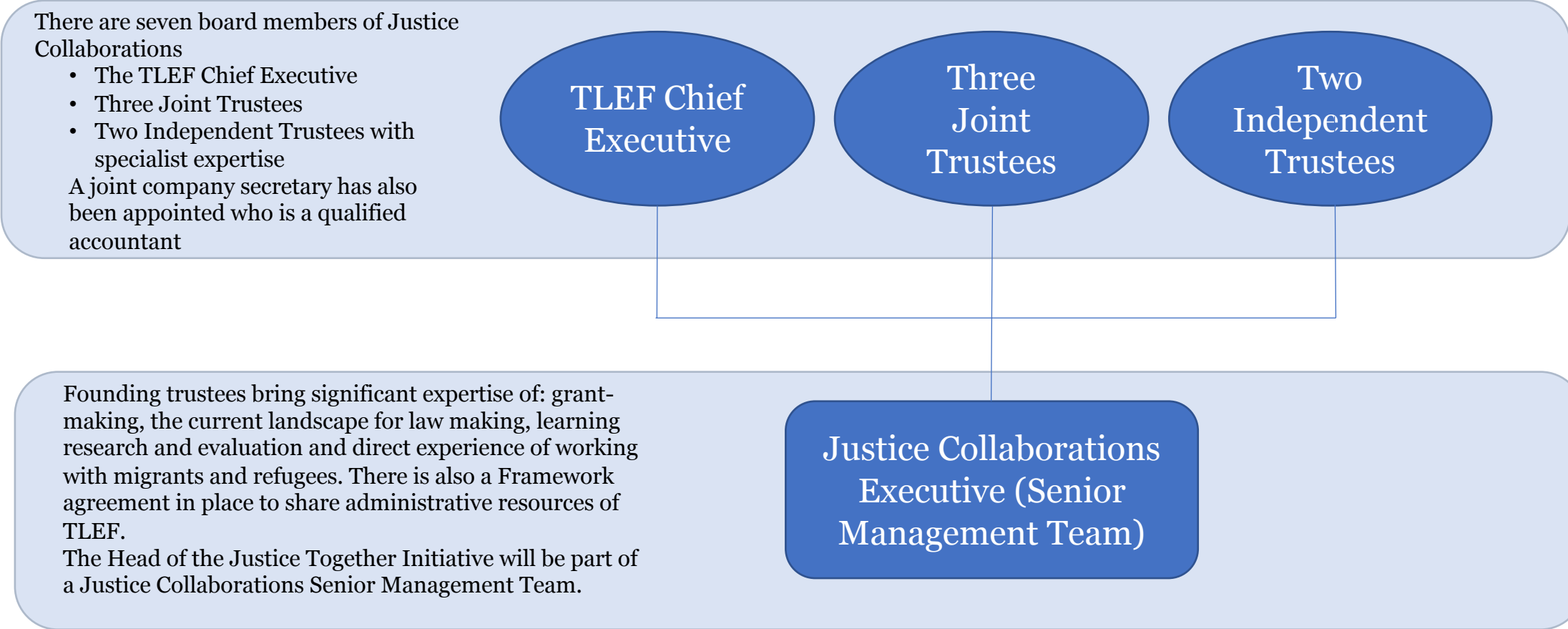

Justice Collaborations' Executive (SMT) will be drawn from The Legal Education Foundation Senior Management Team, ensuring alignment for grant-making, strategy and financial oversight. The Head of Justice Together will work closely with the Director of Strategy at TLEF and the Director of Grants at TLEF. The Initiative Head will be line-managed by the Director of Grants at TLEF.

The Initiative Head is responsible for the management of Justice Together. They will be a member of the SMT for Justice Collaborations and will report directly to the Board on matters regarding the Justice Together Initiative. For administrative functions and resource, finance and grants staff from TLEF will provide services which will be cross charged.

Additional posts will also be recruited, which the Initiative Head will manage. This will include a grants officer to manage and administer Justice Together's grant portfolio. The Justice Collaborations Executive will also recruit a development officer to support funder engagement and fundraising. The post will also manage contracts with independent consultants who will bring additional expertise of learning, convening, the immigration field and collaborative funds.
